Rites Slated Thursday for Provoan, 82

Funeral services for John Morley Burt, 82, of Provo, will be conducted Thursday at 10 a.m. at 260 E. South Temple, at Salt Lake City. Mr. Burt died in Provo Saturday at 11:50 p.m. following a two months' illness.
