Funeral arrangements for Mrs. Mary Ann Lucas Burt, 91, of 117 J street were to be made Tuesday afternoon following arrival of members of her family from out of town.

Mrs. Burt, widow of Captain Andrew H. Burt, Salt Lake City's first city marshal and first bishop of the Twenty-first L. D. S. ward, died Tuesday at her residence of causes incident to age.

A native of Bloxham, Warwickshire, England, Mrs. Burt was born March 31, 1849, a daughter of Edward and Ann Morley Lucas. She came to Utah with her mother when she was 16 years old. Mrs. Burt had been an active member of the L. D. S. church.
