# Ex-Brigham Resident Dies Friday

Mrs. May Rose Rees Horsley, 90, passed away Friday evening in Salt Lake City. She was a former resident of Brigham City, and the last survivor of the 28 children of John Davis Rees, second mayor of Brigham City, in whose honor Rees Pioneer Park is named.

She was born Oct. 4, 1873 in Brigham City, a daughter of John Davis and Zillah Mathias Rees. She was reared and educated in Brigham City.

She was married to John H. Horsley on Jan. 10, 1894 in the Salt Lake LDS Temple. They made their home in Brigham City until 1924 when they moved to Salt Lake City. He passed away Dec. 10, 1937.
