

SERVICES FOR MRS. BODEN

The Second ward chapel was filled to capacity at the funeral services for the late Mrs. Charlotte Boden which were held on Wednesday afternoon under the direction of Bishop T. H. Blackburn.

A beautiful floral display was arranged along the entire rostrum and a great many relatives and friends came from long distances to attend the services.
